APRIL IS NATIONAL SAFE DIGGING MONTH

Call 811 or go online to get a USA ticket three days before you plan to dig. All you have to do is give the address or general location of the project, when you plan to start, and how much digging you'll be doing.
Make sure you dig parallel with the utility line and use precautions when you are removing soil from near the utility line.

3. Use smaller hand tools while digging within 24 inches of the outer edge of underground utility lines. 4. Keep an eye out for signs of a natural gas leak. If you smell something similar to rotten eggs, or hear hissing, whistling, or roaring, it's likely a leak.
