NOMINATING COMMITTEE MEETING

The Board of Directors Nominating Committee Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 7 at 6:00 pm via conference call, for the upcoming Election of Directors which will be held during the Annual Meeting of Members, Thursday, June 17, 2021, by "LIVE" feed on NEMR Telecom's Facebook page. Directors seeking nominations for the 2021 Election are:

Zone 1, Novinger – Mark Grgurich Zone 2, Luray – Junior Bertram Zone 2, Tobin Creek – Jim Kigar

The Nominating Committee Members are Chuck Daniels, Andy Hargrove, Jamie Triplett, and Chuck Yancy.

Pursuant to a revision of Article Four of the Articles of Incorporation adopted at the August 2020 Board of Directors' meeting, the Board determined that the size of the Board should be reduced to seven (7) members through regular resignation or retirement of Directors. Therefore, whenever a current Board member announces an intention to resign or retire, the Board may choose not to hold an election to replace that Director and, instead, reduce the size of the Board.

Presently, there are five (5) Directors from Zone 1 and four (4) Directors from Zone 2. Recognizing that the evolution to a seven-member Board of Directors through resignations and retirements will take time, the Board is authorized to move towards a seven-member Board at its own discretion and pace when determining whether or not to hold an election to replace a resigning or retiring Director.

Pursuant to a revision of Article Four of the Articles of Incorporation adopted at the January and February 2021 Board of Directors' meeting, the 11 districts have been changed to 2 zones with no more than 1 director from an exchange. Zone 1 includes the exchanges: Green City, Lemons, Martinstown, Novinger, Omaha, Pollock, Queen City, Unionville, and Winigan and Zone 2 includes the exchanges: Arbela, Brock, Luray, Memphis and Tobin Creek.

In July 2020, the Federal Communications Commission adopted an order approving the designation of 988 as the 3-digit dialing code for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. To facilitate implementation, area codes across the country where the 988 prefix is a working prefix and which now use 7-digit local dialing must transition to 10-digit local dialing. This includes the 660 area code in our service area.

Starting October 24, 2021, you'll need to dial the 660 area code plus the 7-digit phone number to make local calls. In addition to changing your dialing routine, you'll also have to reprogram 7-digit local numbers to 10-digit numbers if you use speed dial or any other system that automatically makes calls for you.
