



HOW TO BLOCK SPAM EMAIL

Unwanted emails in your NEMR email account can be annoying. Follow these simple instructions below to stop spam and other unwanted email messages:

- 1. Click on e-scout. You receive an e-scout about every day.
- 2. Scroll down to the green bar Delivered Email
- 3. Find the email in the From section or Subject you want to report.
- 4. Click on it. The page that comes up has options. Click on Report SPAM
- 5. You are given choices on the right side to click circles you want to report. Find all the emails received from the unwanted emailers and click the SPAM circle
- 6. Scroll to bottom and click on CONFIRM SELECTED ITEMS
- 7. Repeat as needed to keep your email inbox clean.
