MANDATORY 10-DIGIT DIALING

Beginning **April 24, 2021**, you should begin dialing 10 digits (area code + telephone number) for all local calls. If you forget and dial just 7 digits, your call will still be completed. Beginning on or after **October 24, 2021**, all calls will require 10 digits. Calls within our service area will still be considered local even though you must dial 10 digits. Your telephone number will not change. The price of a call, coverage area, or other rates and services will not change due to the dialing change.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has adopted **988** as a new three-digit number to be used nationwide to reach the National Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Crisis Lifeline starting July 16, 2022. In order for **988** to work in our area code, 10-digit local dialing must first be implemented.

In addition to changing the way you dial local calls, automated dialing equipment that are programmed to complete calls to 7-digit local numbers will need to be reprogrammed. For more information, please call NEMR Telecom or visit <https://www.fcc.gov/suicide-prevention-hotline>.



Many young people have little if any experience with checks making them likelier to become victims. Example: You are looking for a job and someone sends you an email saying, "We'd like to hire you and send you advance payment via check." While it sounds a little weird, you really need the work, so you agree. You receive the check and see that it's for more than the agreed-upon amount. The check writer tells you it was a mistake and asks you to wire the difference back to them. Because it can take days or even weeks to process checks, your bank informs you sometime later that the check was bad, and your bank account is being reduced by the original check amount. That means the cash you sent to the check writer is from your own funds, that person is long gone, and you're out that money with no way to get it back.
