WHAT TO DO IF YOU PAID A SCAMMER....

First thing to do is not to panic!

Scammers can be very convincing. If you have been scammed, it is nothing to be ashamed of. The first thing to do is not panic. Secondly, take action to make sure the scammer does not receive your money.

-If you paid with a credit or debit card, contact the company or bank that issued the card. Tell them it was a fraudulent charge and ask them to reverse the transaction.

-If the scammer made an unauthorized transfer from your bank account, call your bank and tell them it was an unauthorized debit or withdrawal. Ask them to reverse the transaction and give you your money back.

-If you paid with a gift card, contact the company that issued the card and tell them you were scammed. Ask them to refund your money.

-Did you send a wire transfer through a company like Western Union? Contact the wire transfer company and tell them it was a fraudulent transfer. Ask them to reverse the transfer.

-Did you send cash? If you sent it by mail, contact the U.S. Postal Inspection Service and ask them to intercept the package.

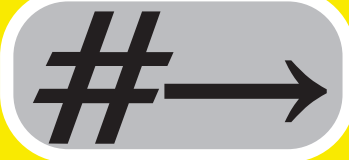
