DO YOU STRUGGLE paying your telephone or internet bill? You may qualify for Lifeline, a federal program that lowers the monthly cost of phone and internet. You may qualify for a discount based on your income or if you use SNAP, Medicaid or other federal programs. To apply for



Lifeline or find out if you qualify, visit lifelinesupport.org. If you do receive federal assistance, you will need proof when applying. The program is limited to one person per household. If you are not able to apply online and would like a paper application, contact NEMR during business hours, 8 a.m-4:30 p.m., M-F.

Affordable Connectivity rogram Save up to \$30 a month on your internet service bill

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a new government program that helps low income households pay for broadband service and internet connected devices. See if your household is eligible by visiting:

Communications services can literally be a lifeline that connects people to their communities. True to its name, the federal Lifeline program provides up to a \$9.25 monthly discount for eligible low-income subscribers.

To qualify to apply for a Lifeline discount, consumers must either have an income that's at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or participate in a federal assistance program. FCC rules prohibit more than one Lifeline service per household.
