PAPER CHECKS ARE NOT AS SAFE AS YOU THINK



Most people know that allowing a thief to get credit card or debit card numbers could lead to fraud. But writing a check for payment is harmless, right? Think again. According to the Federal Trade Commission, many people are unaware of how much damage could

occur if a bad guy gets your checking account number. This is one of the reasons that banks, and other experts, are increasingly urging consumers to use electronic payments instead of writing paper checks. Paper checks have all the information needed for fraud: name, address, phone number, bank routing number, and account number. Mailing or handing over a check exposes your account information and increases the chance of fraud. Electronic payments (cards, bank transfers, ACH, mobile pay, digital wallet) by contrast, are safer and cheaper. Even if you are careful about who you give personal checks to, the disclosure of your account number could occur without you realizing it. In some cases, consumers think they are paying electronically when they use their bank's online payment service. However, in about 20% of cases, the online service processes and mails a paper check to the vendor with the customer's banking information on the check.

Monthly, NEMR receives dozens of bank-issued paper checks that customers believe are paid electronically. "We get the checks in the mail and sometimes they arrive late from the customer's online banking service," says Lori Fleshman, NEMR Billing Manager. "The customer pays the banking service, and the banking service mails NEMR a check," says Fleshman.

If you are using an online bill payment service, ask how the payment is issued; electronically or does the service print and mail the check?
